Why is it hard to admit to being wrong?

What if it also means that others have been harmed?

Have you had a special experience or insight that opened your eyes to spiritual realities?

Describe a time when a familiar passage of Scripture was suddenly opened to you in a fresh insight.

In what ways did the Lord use Paul's temperament and personality when He turned him around?

Is it reasonable that Paul was not aware that his writings were Scripture?

While not creating Scripture, have you found that God had given you just the right words for an occasion?
