WHAT CAUSED THE "MASS EXTINCTION" OF THE DINOSAURS?

7:30 PM, June 15, 2004, Nazareth Hall Chapel, Northwestern College

Modern day consensus in science now acknowledges that world wide extinction events have occurred in our Earth's history. It is now acknowledged that these events were catastrophic as opposed to earlier uniformitarian and localized flood concepts and explanations. Dinosaur extinction theories continue to abound, many based on erroneous assumptions. 
