### TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Have you considered ...

the loon. The loon is a bird—and we know that all birds have hollow bones – right? Wrong! Loons are one of the few birds that have solid bones. Why? Because it eats fish—and in order to get these fish, they need to dive deep. Having hollow bones would be like wearing a life jacket. Imagine yourself trying to dive 200 feet with a life jacket on! This would be fairly difficult. God specially designed the loon with solid bones so that it could catch fish without tremendous difficulty. When you see a loon on the lake, notice how low it rides in the water—it has heavy, non-hollow bones. So, the next you hear a loon call, think of the Master Designer and His special design of the loon's bones.
