The Dead Sea Scrolls

7:30 PM, February 16, 2010, Nazareth Hall Chapel, Northwestern College, Roseville, MN

Dr. Michael Wise is one of the foremost young scholars on the Dead Sea Scrolls and the lead translator of *The Dead Sea Scrolls: A New Translation*. This book tells about the accuracy of our Old Testament but also covers previously unknown texts that were found in the caves of Qumran near the Dead Sea.

Beginning March 12th the scrolls will be on display at the Science Museum of Minnesota. This is the only place you will be able to see them outside of Israel for a very long time. Not only will you be able to see the scrolls here in the Twin Cities, but you will get a preview by a world renown expert to boot. This is an historic event that probably will never be repeated in our country.

All meetings are free and open to the public, an offering will be accepted.





TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
